Interview Guide

Introduction

For the purpose of the first part of the interview, we will define coaching, mentoring, and sponsoring in the following way:

Mentoring is a **longitudinal** process aimed at **career development** through **dialogue**-based guidance.

Coaching is a periodic and focused instruction, often iterative in nature, following an "observe, provide feedback, re-observe" for the coach, to help with skill improvement.

Sponsorship is an episodic action in which an individual provides help with career advancement of someone else.
