

Hepatitis C Questionnaire

1. Do you know that you were diagnosed with Hepatitis C infection?

Options: Yes/No

2. Have you been previously treated for Hepatitis C infection?

Options: Yes/Partly/Do not know/No

Branching logic:

If YES, clarify where they were treated and make sure it is documented in their medical record. Continue onto branching questions 2a and 2b.

For all other response options, continue onto branching question 2c and complete the rest of the survey.

- 2a. If you said YES, did you complete treatment for your Hep C infection?

Options: Yes/No

- 2b. Were there any obstacles to your treatment? Choose the reason that fits best:

- No obstacles to treatment
- I did not want to take the medication
- I had transportation problems
- I had insurance/financial issues
- Other - write in

- 2c. If you said PARTLY, DO NOT KNOW or NO, why haven't you gotten treated before now? Choose the reason that fits best:

- I never got a referral/No one contacted me
- I had transportation problems
- I had Insurance/Financial issues
- I did not want to be treated
- Other - write in

3. Do you understand what hepatitis C infection is?

Options: Yes/Somewhat/No

Branching logic:

- a. If YES, skip Question 4; go to Question 5 and complete the rest of the survey.
- b. If SOMEWHAT/NO, continue to Question 4 and complete the rest of the survey.

4. Did a doctor / medical professional ever explain to you what hepatitis C infection is?

Options: Yes/Not sure/No

5. Do you know that if Hepatitis C is not treated, it can harm your liver and might even lead to cancer?

Options: Yes/No

6. There is effective treatment for hepatitis C. This involves taking medication once a day for 8 weeks. Would you like to start taking this medication?

Options: Yes/Not sure/No
